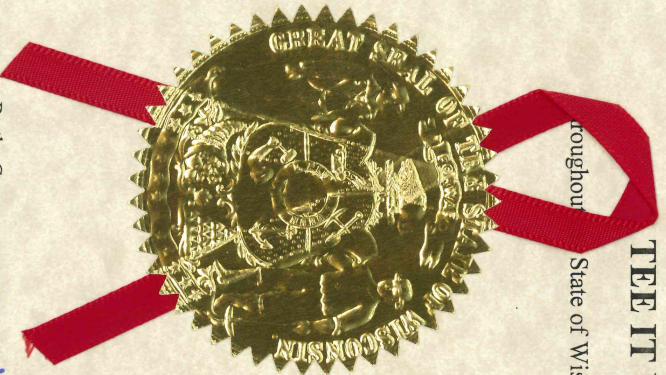
NOW, *WHEREFORE*, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim Friday, September 9, 2011, as
